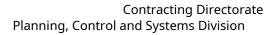

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

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1 RECEIPT OF ELECTRONIC NOTIFICATIONS


This quick guide outlines the steps to follow when reading electronic notifications sent by the corresponding Aena contracting unit.

An electronic notification is a message that a contracting unit sends to a bidder through the notification module of the Electronic Tendering Platform. *eLicita* from Aena, which may or may not be in response to a communication made by the bidder.

1.1 Step 1. Access to the electronic notifications module

Bidders can access the electronic notification module in two different ways:

1.**Electronic Notification Notice**The bidder receives an email at the address provided, notifying them of a new electronic notification. The email also provides a direct access URL to the notification module: https://elicita.aena.es/SNE_Internet/.



2. **Direct access** to the electronic notification module from the URL: https://elicita.aena.es/SNE_Internet/.



- If the bidder has not received the email in their inbox, they should check that it is not in their spam folder.

Likewise, there are 3 types of electronic notifications:



- **GPA**. Electronic notifications rrelated to the registration of the bidder (natural or legal person) on the platform. The electronic notification email is sent to the address provided in the registration application.
- UTES Electronic notifications related to the registration of the bidder (temporary business association) on the platform. The electronic notification email is sent to the address provided in the registration application.
- Hiring. Electronic notifications related to a tendering procedure The electronic notification email is sent to the email address provided when submitting your bid for the specific tender.

1.2 Step 2. Authentication in the notification module

To access the notification module, the company or joint venture must authenticate with the electronic certificate or username and password of the representative who previously submitted an offer or who appears as such in the application for registration in the system.







1.3 Step 3. Notifications pending reading

The first screen that the bidder sees when accessing the electronic notifications module, whether using an electronic certificate or a username and password, shows a direct link to the number of unread notifications.





The bidder can access the list of unread electronic notifications from the shortcut indicated in the previous step or through *UNREAD NOTIFICATIONS* in the menu on the left, as can be seen in the following screenshot:



1.4 Step 4. Reading electronic notifications

Regardless of how the bidder accesses the pending electronic notifications, the system will display a list with the details of each electronic notification.

Once the bidder has accessed the list of unread electronic notifications, they can click on the icon to access the electronic notification.

If you log in to the system with a digital certificate, you will see the following screen:








Notifications will appear**rejected**When the reading period established by the contracting unit has expired or they have been intentionally rejected by the bidder. Even so, in these cases, the system allows them to be read. Subsequently, the status of that notification will change from rejected to**read-rejected**.

The "Notification Detail" screen displays the following data, distributed as shown below:

The operations that the bidder can perform on this screen are the following:

<< Volver The functionality associated with this button returns to the unread notifications window.

Verificar firma

The functionality associated with this button shows the electronic signature data with which the electronic notification has been made.

Leer The functionality associated with this button initiates the notification reading process.

Rehusar
The functionality associated with this button initiates the notification rejection process.





To proceed with the **reading** either **rejection** of an electronic notification, **The bidder must use his electronic certificate or, where applicable, his username and password.** to perform a signature operation, in the same way that happens when the postman delivers an electronic notification notice to you in person.

The same screen displays the content of the electronic notification: the subject and the text written by the contracting unit.


The bidder may download the documentation attached to the notification, in case the body of contract has been sent, by clicking on this icon

If the bidder is required to submit a bid, it must use the methodology described in section 2 of the "Quick guide to submitting bids - Submission of corrections. If the bidder has to correct documentation, you will have to use the methodology described in section 3 of the "Quick guide to submitting bids". - Documentation requirement from the potential successful bidder. If the tenderer is required to submit documents as a potential successful bidder, it must use the methodology described in section 4 of the "Quick guide to submitting bids".
<< Volver	The functionality associated with this button displays The functionality associated with this button returns to the unread notifications window.
Verificar firma	The functionality associated with this button displays the data of the electronic signature with which the electronic notification was made.
Guardar acuse	The bidder may download the acknowledgment of receipt in PDF format.


1.5 Step 5. Query notifications

If the bidder prefers, they can view all their electronic notifications, both those pending and those previously read in previous days.

You can do this through "My Notifications" in the menu on the left or by clicking the "View all my notifications" link on the home screen.



Whether accessed through the menu or the link, the following search screen will appear, where you can select whether the notifications you want to view are read or unread, among other filters.







1.6 Step 6. Response to the notification

The notification response feature is not intended for submitting bids, submitting corrections, or requesting documentation from the potential successful bidder.

- If the bidder has to submit an offer, he will have to use the methodology described in section 2 of the "Quick quide to submitting bids
- If the bidder has to correct documentation, he will have to use the methodology described in section 3 of the "Quick guide to submitting bids".
- Documentation requirement from the potential successful bidder. If the tenderer is required to submit documents as a potential successful bidder, it must use the methodology described in section 4 of the "Quick guide to submitting bids".

The bidder may respond to a notification sent by the contracting unit using the "Reply to Notification" feature.





REQUIRED FIELDS

Subject of the response. Accents and special characters are not allowed in the text field.

Response text.Accents and special characters are not allowed in the text field.

If the bidder wishes<u>provide documentation</u> to the electronic communication, you must click names of attached files may not contain spaces or accents.





Remember that the process of sending electronic communications from the notification module does not end until the bidder checks the box indicating that he has read and accepted

the legal conditions, click on the button electronic to sign and send the electronic communication.
